

Lift Safety Zone (F-9107)

This year NCCCO's flagship exhibit-the Lift Safety Zone-will be located at the Las Vegas Festival Grounds (F-9107), along with exhibits from most major crane and equipment manufacturers. At the LSZ attendees will learn how limiting factors can affect a crane's load ratings and load dynamics, including how issues such as line pull,quadrants of operation, wire rope layers on the winch, and similar factors impact crane safety and proper load handling. Attendees will also be able see firsthand the practical exam process for the *Tower Crane Zig-Zag Course* and watch a live demonstration of the NCCCO Rigger Level II Practical Exam rigging frame rotation and level lift tasks. NCCCO staff and volunteers will be available to answer questions about the certification process and regulatory issues affecting the crane and rigging industry, and help individuals begin their journey to becoming an NCCCO-certified operator, rigger, or signalperson.
